We want to know what children have in common by asking questions to caregivers using a questionnaire called the Strengths-Based Identification Tool.


> Dr. Elizabeth Cleveland, through Partners for Inclusive Communities and the College of Education and Health Professions at the University of Arkansas, is conducting the study.
